Public transport

The Princess Máxima Center is located opposite the Wilhelmina Children's Hospital (WKZ) in the Utrecht Science Park and is easily accessible by public transport. For a complete overview, see www.usp-bereikbaar.nl. From Utrecht Central Station, tram 20, 21 and 22 stops at the Princess Máxima Center. You get off at the second to last stop WKZ/Máxima, opposite the entrance of our center. Bus 28 also stops here. Visitors or parents who park in P+R Utrecht Science Park can take tram 20, 21 and 22 or bus 28 to the Máxima (one stop, journey takes 1 minute).

By bicycle

For children, parents or visitors travelling by bike, you can plan your route via Google Maps. **Note:** The Princess Máxima Center is opposite the WKZ and has its own entrance for bicycles, mopeds/scooters and cars/motorbikes. When arriving at the WKZ, do NOT go left to the WKZ's carpark and bicycle parking, but cross the tram and bus lane at the traffic lights and drive onto the Hoofddijk. From the Hoofddijk, turn left onto the paved road, continue past our building to the bicycle parking, left of the main entrance. **Bicycle Parking:** The bicycle parking facility is located on the left next to the main entrance. You have free access to this but you do need an access card (available from reception).

By car


By car to A27, exit De Uithof/H-UMC:

From the A28 from a north/east direction (Amersfoort, A1 Apeldoorn / Enschede, A28 Zwolle / Groningen): A28 towards Utrecht. For junction Rijnsweerd, take exit 2 (De Uithof/H-UMC).

From the A27 from the north (A27 Hilversum / Almere, A1 het Gooi / Amsterdam): A27 towards Utrecht. At Utrecht, follow the signs De Uithof/H-UMC. At junction Rijnsweerd, take exit 2 (De Uithof/H-UMC).

From the A27 from the south (A27 Gorinchem / Breda, A2 Den Bosch / Eindhoven / Maastricht): A27 towards Utrecht, at Utrecht (junction Rijnsweerd), take the A28 towards Amersfoort. Then follow the signs De Uithof/H-UMC (exit 2).

From the A12 from the east (Ede, Arnhem, Nijmegen) and west towards (Gouda, Den Haag, Rotterdam): At Utrecht (Lunetten junction) follow the A27 towards Amersfoort / Hilversum. Then (junction Rijnsweerd) take the A28 towards Amersfoort. Follow the signs De Uithof/H-UMC (exit 2).



From exit De Uithof/H-UMC to the parking garage of the Princess Máxima Center (1st car parents)

At the end of the exit, turn left at the traffic lights towards De Uithof/UMC. At the fork of Universiteitslaan / Lundlaan, turn left and cross the Universiteitslaan towards WKZ. Follow the sign for Princess Máxima Center and turn left. At the traffic lights by the tram and bus lane, **go straight,** cross the tram and bus lane and enter the Hoofddijk and immediately turn left onto the paved road. You then drive past the front of the Princess Máxima Center to the entrance of the parking garage.

From exit De Uithof/H-UMC to P+R Utrecht Science Park (visitors and 2nd car parents)

From the direction of Amersfoort:

At the end of the exit, turn left at the traffic lights towards De Uithof/UMC. Turn right at the next traffic lights: this is the driveway to the P+R Utrecht Science Park.

From the direction of Utrecht:

At the end of the exit, go straight at the traffic lights: this is the driveway to the P+R Utrecht Science Park.

From the direction of P+R Utrecht Science Park:

You can take tram 20, 21 and 22 or bus 28 to the Princess Máxima Center (one stop, journey takes 1 minute). It is a 10-minute walk.

Parking

The Princess Máxima Center parking garage is intended for parents (1 parking spot) of children staying in our center or visiting the outpatient clinic. A doctor's assistant will give you a discount card for the parking garage.

For emergency admissions, or admissions outside of regular opening hours, discount cards are available at the security. The P+R Utrecht Science Park is for visitors or parents' 2nd car. See rates below. You can pay with pin at the reception desk.
